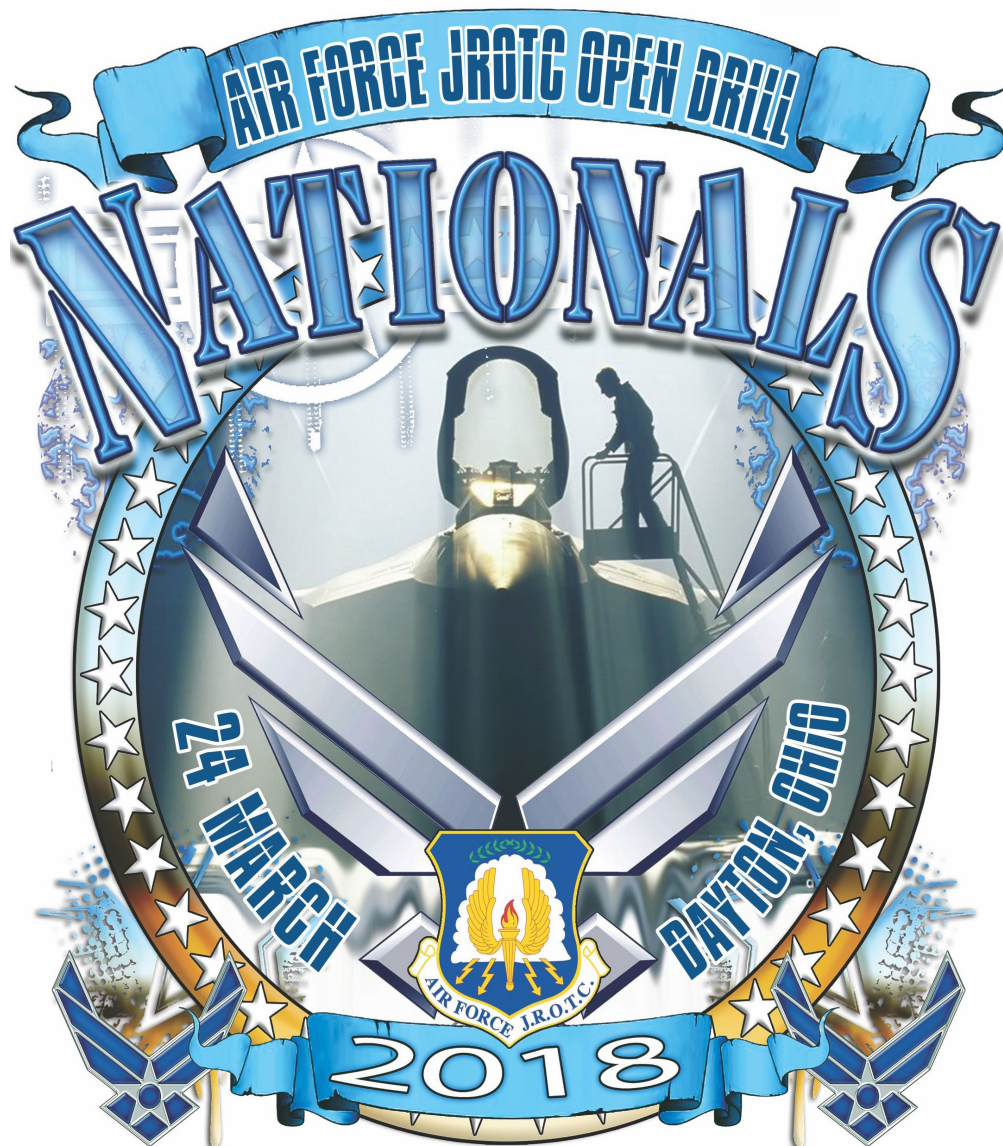
- ◆ Cadets can attend individually or as a group.

Colonel Paul Lips is the Director, Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps, Maxwell Air Force Base, AL. He is responsible for the Air Force's high school citizenship training program comprised of about 125,000 students and 1,900 instructors at 889 high schools worldwide. Colonel Lips directs staff initiatives and policy to implement the world's largest and most comprehensive aerospace science education program. Col Lips was commissioned through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps and entered active duty in February 1995. A career space operations officer, he has served in multiple operational, staff, and leadership positions including Headquarters Air Force Branch Chief, Basic Training Squadron Commander, and Technical Training Deputy Group Commander. In 2005 Col Lips supported Keesler AFB's reconstruction efforts and reconstitution of training following Hurricane Katrina. In his previous assignment he was the Chief of Staff, 455th Air Expeditionary Wing, Bagram Airfield, Afghanistan.
