

The campus dorms in use for the NDC are very standard university dorm rooms. Each room has a set of twin bunk beds, a dresser, room for hanging clothes, and a mirror. It is not like staying in a hotel, there are no televisions or private bathrooms. Each person attending has a community bathroom with private shower stalls and restroom stalls (think high school locker room).

Each cadet will be provided with a flat and fitted sheet, 1 pillow, 1 pillowcase, and one light blanket by SNI. No housekeeping service will be provided. Trash is emptied from each room into a hallway trashcan and collected by building staff daily. Each resident is responsible for making their own bed and keeping their room neat.

You are welcome to bring your own bedding should you desire. We recommend that you bring your **own pillow** for sure! You will need to bring a bath towel, washcloth and all necessary toiletries, including soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, shampoo and any other hair care items, shaving kit, and other personal hygiene items.

You will need to pack the following items:

- ★ IMPORTANT: CADETS ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR APPROPRIATE CLOTHING AT ALL TIMES. PANTS MUST FIT AT THE WAIST, SHORTS SHOULD TOUCH MID THIGH – THINK HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE. NO SUGGESTIVE OR REVEALING CLOTHING. NO SPAGHETTI STRAPS. BOTTOM LINE: WEAR CLOTHES BEFITTING A MILITARY CADET AT A MILITARY DRILL CAMP
- ☆ 6 pair of shorts and 6 t-shirts for PT
- ★ 6 casual outfits for daily classroom and outdoor practical activities (School spirit attire is encouraged!)
- 2 pair of jeans/slacks and casual shirts (for evening fun time)
- 6 days of socks minimum (you will be changing clothes after PT every day)
- ★ 6 days of undergarments minimum (you will be changing clothes after PT every day)
- A comfortable pair of sneakers (you will be marching a minimum of 2 miles each day to and from chow)
- Pillow and blanket (IF YOU GET COLD EASILY) from home if desired for comfort
- At least one bath towel and washcloth for daily showers (no towels will be provided)
- At least one hand towel (for drying hands at in-room sink)
- ☆ 1 pair sandals, flip-flops or water shoes for shower
- 쓝 Soap, Deodorant, Shaving Kit, Shampoo / Conditioner, Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Sunscreen (WE ALWAYS HAVE SOME ON HAND SO DON'T BUY IT IF YOU DON'T HAVE IT!)
- Required Medications (Medication Authorization Form must be completed)
- ★ Laundry bag for dirty laundry (or an extra pillow case)
- \Rightarrow Plan to bring enough clothes for the week. Laundry is not easily accessible.

You may bring the following, but it is not required:

- Your personal uniform if you have permission from your JROTC instructor
- Your personal weapon we will have weapons available, but if you prefer to use your own, you may bring it
- 🛠 Cell phone you will only be allowed to use it during personal time so plan to leave it in the dorm room
- Books or other reading material please make sure the content is not inappropriate
- ☆ Personal electronics gameboy, IPOD be sure to bring headphones for your use
- A small amount of spending money for in-between meal snacks and souvenirs if desired
- A camelback if you like to use it. We will issue water bottles to every cadet.

DO NOT BRING

- ★ Attire with any objectionable or inappropriate statements or images
- Knives (including pocket knives) or any other item that can be utilized as a weapon
- 쓝 Jewelry if you cannot wear it during military inspection, don't bring it.
- Tobacco products (for any cadet campers) instructor participants will have access to smoking areas
