Nationals Drill Camp

Those instructors choosing to attend through the limited fournight packages will have access to some, but not all of these combined courses.

Instructor Session #1: Recruitment & Retention

Maintaining a competitive drill team can be an excellent resource for recruiting cadets into your program. Instructors will explore additional avenues for boosting the numbers of quality cadets in your program. Keeping your program thriving by retaining the best cadets will also be explored along with insight into different types of JROTC programs and how their extracurricular teams work throughout the school year.

Teaching Males vs. Females & Teenage Psychology
